WAYNE BURNETT GATHERS HIS SQUAD TOGETHER AFTER OUR WIN OVER CHELSEA IN THE PREVIOUS ROUND

UNDER-21S RETURN TO N17

This evening marks our Under-21s' first run-out at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium since our memorable play-off winning campaign in 2023/24.

As winners of the league phase of the competition, we were handed home ties in each of our play-offs matches and after seeing off Aston Villa 4-3 after extra time at Stevenage, we won our quarter-final, semi-final and final outings here at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium to lift the overall silverware.

All three of those latter games took place in May, 2024, as we first defeated Liverpool on penalties after a 3-3 draw, then dramatically beat Chelsea 2-1 before seeing off Sunderland 3-1 in the final.

We also staged a fourth match here at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium that season, a 6-0 thrashing of Fleetwood Town in the Premier League Cup in February, 2024, that was memorable for a dazzling solo goal by Yago Santiago, in addition to a quickfire hat-trick from Will Lankshear.

Those results meant we remain unbeaten here at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium at Development Squad level, dating back to our first Premier League 2 outing here

against Manchester City in 2019 – the year the stadium opened.

Tonight marks the second time we've hosted a Premier League 2 fixture here against Brighton, having drawn 0-0 with the Seagulls back in May, 2022, when the competition was an Under-23 league.

Led by Wayne Burnett and assistant coach Troy Archibald-Henville, our Under-21s this season finished the league stage in eighth spot and after a 1-0 home win over Leicester City in our first play-off match on 24 April, a superb 3-1 comeback victory at Chelsea last Friday night booked our place in this evening's semi-final. Visitors Brighton, meanwhile, were 12th in the table and after winning 2-1 at Ipswich Town, they advanced to tonight's tie with a 3-0 home victory over 10-man West Ham United on Monday night.

We've seen a number of success stories over the course of the campaign, with a handful of first team debuts and other players shining while out on loan in addition to some top performances in the Premier League 2 – here's hoping for another one tonight as we look to take a step closer to emulating our success of 2023/24.
